

SCSH LADY PUTTERS BUSINESS MEETING – Dec. 18, 2014 (#2 of 4)

Under new business:

January 5th is Beat the Pro, Dixie our new female golf pro will be playing against us in the first session. Her score will be used as the one to beat for both sessions. All those beating the pro's score will be awarded a Beat the Pro pin.

Sarah Cyr reported on the upcoming "Go for the Red" event where the proceeds of our morning putting will go to the American Heart Association. Any hole-in-one payouts will go to the charity but will count towards pins. Additional funds may be donated on a voluntary basis separately.

Diana Berry explained the upcoming January 30th tournament with Palm Desert. It is open to the first 36 members of our club who drop their check in our mailbox and 36 putters from Palm Desert. If they do not have 36, we will fill in with our members. The cost is \$30 and we will be playing scratch. Hole-in-ones will pay \$2 instead of the usual \$1. Sign up starts immediately.

Bette Lou Robinson then drew numbers for the Charlie brown trees which had served as our centerpieces. Previously the Charlie Brown door prizes had been raffled off in the same manner.

The business meeting was adjourned at 1:50 p.m.
