

SCSH Lady Putters

A Summary of Key Information

- Putting sessions are on Monday mornings. The standard times are:
 Session 1 - 8:00 am (Sign-in by 7:45 am)
 Session 2 - 9:15 am (Sign-in by 9:00 am)

Members may attend either session (but only one session each play day). Session times and the number of sessions will change in the summer depending on the weather (heat!) and the number of members playing.

- Check out the Lady Putters website (shputters.com) weekly to view events and announcements.
- Membership dues are \$20 per year, for membership from January 1st to December 31st, checks payable to *SCSH Lady Putters*. **New members will need to complete a registration form and sign the *SCSH Informed Consent, Release and Waiver Agreement*. PLEASE KEEP YOUR E-MAIL ADDRESS CURRENT WITH US, AS THAT IS OUR PRIMARY METHOD OF COMMUNICATION.**
- Be sure you bring to each session \$2 for the playing fee, a putter, and a golf ball. We usually have a few loaners in the cupboard.
- Our “uniform” consists of a blue logo shirt and white short/pants/skirt. The logo shirt, an optional blue apron (and other items,) can be purchased from our Uniform Chairperson. The apron is highly recommended as it provides a place to hold the scorecard, pencil, ball, and any other items you wish to carry while putting. We do adhere to standard golf dress codes including no jeans, no golf spikes or flip-flops. Summer dress code: no uniform required, however, sleeveless shirts require a collar. **No tank tops, crop tops or short-shorts allowed.**
- Be sure both you and your playing partner sign the scorecard after you play and before you submit your completed scorecard.
- Awards are given for holes-in-one: \$1 is paid for each hole-in-one earned that day. The accumulation of 5 holes-in-one is awarded with a “bird” pin. Three or more holes-in-one in a playing session earns a “big bird” pin. Five small bird pins can be traded in for a fancier “super bird” pin. These pins are typically worn on the player's apron. You can track your scores and holes-in-one on your “*Personal Manager*” card.
- You will receive a handicap after submitting 5 putting scores, the handicaps are updated monthly which can be viewed at a putting session and on our website. This handicap will be subtracted from your “gross” score to compute a “net” score. Refer to the “*Handicaps*” sheet included for details.
- Rules for putting and scoring are located on the Lady Putters website and in this handout. Although your playing partners can assist you with these rules while you play, it is highly recommended that you review the rules. On our website click on *Club Info, Standing Rules*.
- One of the best ways to engage in the club is to volunteer! Sign up to volunteer at the sign-in desk and you will have the opportunity to meet all the players in that session. Sign up to help with our various events: including decorations, food, or cleanup. Please share your time and talents with us!!
