

SCSH LADY PUTTERS
STANDING RULES
(Revised October 2017)

1. CLUB YEAR:

January 1 – December 31.....Official Playing season
October.....Putting course closed for reseeding
January 1 – December 31.....Term of office for Board Members

2. DUES: Annual dues shall be \$20.00 for those who join or renew, between January and December. New members who join November and December shall pay \$5.00 for the remainder of the fiscal year plus \$20 for the following year January 1 through December 31. No Refunds. Dues are payable to play.

3. WEEKLY DUES: Members shall pay a fee of \$2.00 each week that they play. This fee covers payouts for the holes-in-one, prizes and other expenses.

4. HOLES-IN-ONE: One dollar (\$1.00) will be paid to dues-paying members for each hole-in-one, also called “birdie”, made during weekly play.

5. BIRDIE PINS: A small bird pin will be awarded to each dues-paying member for every five (5) holes-in-one made during the Club Year. If there are less than five (5) holes-in-one recorded at the end of the season, the number remaining will be carried over to the start of the next Club year. A Big bird pin will be awarded for any three (3) holes-in-one made in one day during the Club year by a dues-paying member. At the option of the member, five (5) small bird pins may be traded in for one (1) Super bird pin.

6. UNIFORMS: The official putting attire that must be worn during the Club Year is a SCSH Royal Blue golf shirt, and your choice of white shorts, slacks, skirts, or skorts. During the summer play a shirt of your choice may be worn. This should be sleeveless with a collar, or collarless with sleeves. No tank tops, crop-tops, or short-shorts are allowed.

7. SHOES: Only flat-soled shoes or tennis shoes will be permitted on the green. No flip-flops for safety reasons. In order to protect the green, no heels or any kind of golf shoes with spikes will be allowed.

8. HANDICAPS: Handicaps will be calculated monthly for dues-paying members. A member must putt a total of five (5) games, which need not be consecutive, to receive a handicap. Note: Although handicaps will be calculated for information purposes, it is the gross scores that will be recorded for all members. If, in the future, the SCSH Lady Putters Club joins with the Desert Putters Association, handicaps are required for invitational tournament play.

9. STATISTICS CARRYOVER: Member statistics (holes-in-ones and gross scores for handicaps) will be carried over from one club year to the next if the member pays dues in full prior to the deadline for dues – January 1 of the new club year.

10. GUESTS: Guests are welcome to putt free, but they will not be eligible for any prizes (e.g. holes-in-one payouts, accrual of “birdies”). Residents may play as a guest one time only; they must then pay dues and purchase a shirt, if they wish to continue putting during the Club Year. All guests will be required to sign the SCSH Liability Waiver and furnish their Community Association number.
